Research has shown that each learner needs three 10-minute practice sessions per skill in the simulator. Advocates provides learners with an instructional coach to offer real-time feedback in the classroom simulator and/or to provide on-going technical assistance and follow-up support. Additionally, the simulator can be used by learners individually, or with groups of up to three people. There is greater impact if learners rehearse their skills individually, but for large districts and/or limited budgets, learners can be grouped into trios to rehearse the same skill and observe their colleagues' rehearsal as well.
